- 1. (U) FOLLOWING IS A SITUATION REPORT ON KOREA PREPARED IN THE DEPARTMENT AS OF 0900 EDT MAY 25 (251300ZMAY):
- 2. (C) THE STUATION IN KWANGJU HAS TAKEN A RATHER GRIM TURN. THE MCCERATE CITIZENS COMMITTEE HAS LOST CONTROL OF THE SITUATION AND THE RADICALS APPEAR TO BE IN CHARGE. PEOPLES COURTS HAVE BEEN SET UP AND SOME EXECUTIONS HAVE TAKEN PLACE. STUDENT DEMONSTRATORS HAVE BEEN LARGELY

REPLACED BY UNIDENTIFIED ARMED RADICALS WHO ARE TALKING OF SETTING UP A REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT.

3. (S) ARMY STRONGMAN GENERAL CHUN DOO HWAN (M-R: CHON TU-HWAN) IS REPORTED TO HAVE CONCLUDED THAT HE HAS BEEN DECEIVED BY THE RADICALS WITHIN KWANGJU AND THAT MILITARY ACTION WILL NOW BE REQUIRED. AMBASSADOR GLEYSTEEN REPORTS THAT A DELEGATION OF SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS WILL GO TO KWANGJU MONDAY MORNING TO MAKE ONE LAST TRY TO RESOLVE THE SITUATION, BUT IF THEY FAIL THEN MILITARY ACTION TO



REGAIN CONTROL OF THE CITY WILL PROBABLY TAKE PLACE WITHIN 24-36 HOURS. THE ROK CHAIRMAN OF THE JCS HAS PROMISED TO INFORM US BEFORE THE MOVE TAKES PLACE.

- 4. (C) AMERICAN CITIZENS -- THE KOREAN FOREIGN MINISTRY HAS NOW PIOUSLY REQUESTED THAT ALL FOREIGNERS LEAVE KWANGUU FOR THEIR OWN SAFETY. AMERICAN EMBASSY AND MILITARY AUTHORITIES IN KOREA HAVE FORMED A TASK FORCE, WHICH IS WORKING LATE SUNDAY NIGHT ON THIS PROBLEM. INITIAL CONCLUSIONS ARE, HOWEVER, THAT THERE IS NO WAY TO EXTRACT THE REMAINING AMERICANS SAFELY AND THAT THERE IS SOMEWHAT GREATER SAFETY NO IN THEIR LYING LOW IN PLACE. THOSE REMAINING (25-30 PERSONS, INCLUDING FIVE PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEERS, MISSIONARIES AND ACADEMICS) HAD UNWISELY DISREGARDED STRONG WARNINGS FROM THE AMERICAN AMBASSADOR URGING THEM REPEATEDLY TO LEAVE KWANGUU IN THE LAST FEW DAYS WHEN THIS WAS FEASIBLE TO DO. THE FIVE PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEERS DEFIED A DIRECT ORDER TO LEAVE. ONCE OUT OF KWANGOU, THEY WILL BE SENT HOME.
- 5. (S) RERORTS FROM KWANGUU SAY THAT GOVERNMENT RADIO BROADCASTS TO THE CITY ARE SAYING NOT ONLY THAT THE U.S. HAS RELEASED FORCES FOR USE IN MAINTAINING PUBLIC ORDER, BUT THAT WE ARE ENCOURAGING THE USE OF TROOPS

IN THIS ROLE, GENERAL WICKHAM HAS PROTESTED IN STRONG TERMS YOUVHE MARTIAL LAW COMMAND AND WILL MAKE A PUBLIC DENIAL ID. THE REPORTS ARE NOT CORRECTED.

- 6. (S) KOREAN MILITARY PLANNING FOR HOW TO DEAL WITH THE RADICAL TÜRN OF EVENTS IN KWANGJU IS STILL UNDERWAY, AND WE' HAVE URGED THE MOST CAREFUL AND RESTRAINED USE OF FORCE IN ORDER TO NIMIMIZE INNOCENT CASUALTIES. AN OMINOUS DANGER IN THE SITUATION IS POSED BY THE FACT THAT THE TWO THOUSAND PLUS WEAPONS COLLECTED PEACEFULLY EARLIER FROM DEMONSTRATORS BY THE KWANGJU CITIZENS COMMITTEE ARE STILL WITHIN THE CITY. IT HAS NOT BEEN POSSIBLE FOR THE COMMITTEE TO MOVE THE COLLECTED WEAPONS PAST THE BARRICADES MANNED BY THE RADICALS AND INTO THE HANDS OF THE MILITARY FORCES. THUS THE BULK OF THE RECOVERED WEAPONS ARE VULNERABLE TO BEING SEIZED BY THE RADICALS APPARENTLY SET UPON REVOLUTION. THE NUMBER OF RADICALS INVOLVED IS NOT CLEARLY KNOWN, BUT THERE ARE REPORTS OF ABOUT 50 HARD CORE PLUS ABOUT 500 WILLING FOLLOWERS.
- 7. (C) OUR BRANCH PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICER, WHO HAS NOW ARRIVED IN SEOUL, BROUGHT A MESSAGE FROM CATHOLIC BISHOP YUN, WHO HAS BEEN ACTIVE IN THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE IN KWANGJU, STRESSING THAT IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT THE KOREAN GOVERNMENT APOLOGIZE FOR THE BRUTALITY DISPLAYED BY
